The post is suitable for Physically Handicapped [Orthopaedically Handicapped / Locomotor Disability / Cerebral Palsy(One Leg Affected)] candidates. Qualifications: Essential: A. Educational: Master's degree in Economics or Commerce of a recognized University or equivalent. B. Experience: Two years experience of Economic Research / Investigation. Desirable: Experience of research in the field of Industrial Development. Duties: Research / Investigation in relation to Industrial Development, collection, compilation and interpretation of Economic and Statistical data. HQ : New Delhi. Any Other Conditions: Working Knowledge of Software, Computer will be preferred.
