1.(Ref.No.F.1/154/2009-R-VI/SPC-I) Eighty-four Junior Works Managers (Mechanical) in Ordnance Factory Board, Department of Defence Production, Ministry of Defence. Civilian in Defence Services. Out of eighty four posts, fourteen posts are reserved for SC candidates, three posts are reserved for ST candidates & fifty-two posts are reserved for OBC candidates. Of the eighty-four posts, three posts are reserved for Physically Handicapped persons[viz one post for persons with disability of Hearing Impairment(Partially Deaf) and two posts for persons with disability of Orthopaedically Handicapped /Locomotor disability or Cerebral palsy with One Arm affected or One Leg affected] from any community. These posts are also suitable for persons with disabilities viz. Hearing Impairment (Partially Deaf) or Orthopaedically Handicapped/Locomotor disability or Cerebral Palsy with One Arm affected or One Leg affected. Qualifications: Essential : Educational : Degree in Mechanical Engineering or equivalent from a recognized University.
